OPEN AND NON-PRO HALTER & PERFORMANCE FUTURITY RULES**

The 2008 BRQHA Halter and Performance Futurity will be held on August 28, 29, 30 at the Virginia Horse Center, Lexington, VA. It will be held in conjunction with 3 AQHA shows.

**Please read all rules completely. It is your responsibility to be aware of special requirements for class entries.**

**BRQHA and/or Show Management assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury or damage to persons, horses or personal property for any cause and admittance and entries are accepted only on the basis.**

**The Judges decision is final. It shall be accepted in the spirit of true sportsmanship. Complaints may only be made in writing to Futurity officials.**

**A current negative Coggins test on all horses twelve months of age or older is required.**

**All owners and exhibitors must be members in good standing with BRQHA and AQHA. Membership fees may be mailed in with entries or paid at the show. NSBA exhibitors must meet all NSBA membership requirements. Membership fees must be paid to the Show Secretary before a show number will be issued.**

**All Futurity entries will be assigned a back number and this number MUST be used all 3 days in Futurity and AQHA classes.**

**FUTURITY ENTRY FEES ARE \$100 POSTMARKED BY AUGUST 1. AFTER AUGUST 1, ALL FEES ARE \$150. An NSBA Sanction Fee of \$6 Will Be Added For All NSBA Approved Classes and a \$15.00 office charge per horse. All Futurity entries should be made by 6pm Friday, August 28, 2009.**

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETE. Owners and exhibitors must have full addresses, phone number, social security numbers and AQHA and/or NSBA ID numbers and expiration dates. A COPY OF THE HORSE'S REGISTRATION AND/OR BREEDER'S CERTIFICATE MUST BE INCLUDED. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ALLOWED ON FUTURITY ENTRIES. THERE WILL BE A \$50 FEE CHARGED ON ALL SUBSTITUTIONS. SUBSTITUTIONS MUST BE MADE BY 6PM Friday August 28. All NSBA entries must have a copy of the exhibitors and owners current membership ID or you will have to purchase at the entry desk prior to being issued a show number.**

**All foals must have a Breeder's Certificate or registration papers. No exceptions. Foals without registration papers will be shown as "unnamed".**

**Futurity purse will be mailed out 30 working days after the Futurity provided that the entry has been completed in full with correct mailing address and social security number of owner.**

**A \$40 service charge will be made on returned checks.**

**No entry fees will be refunded unless the class is cancelled.**

**A tiebreaker judge will be determined before each class is shown. In case of a tie, ties will be broken for awards only. All monies will be combined and split equally.**

**Medical Waste (needles, syringes) must NOT be discarded in stalls, manure pits, garbage cans or on the grounds. Medical Waste must be placed in the appropriate containers located in each barn.**
